



Drawing & Sculpture – Focus on Mayan sculpture and in particular the stela. A stela was a large tall stone slab covered with carvings and writing.

Drawing & Materials and Textiles – Focus on Egyptian images and then planning and sketching an Ancient Egyptian Cartouche, before completing their design using fabric.
