Key texts we will read this half term:


























Our Autumn 2 theme, 'I wonder how different people celebrate?', is a fantastic way to explore our differences and enables us to open our minds to new experiences, ideas and ways of thinking. Understanding what different cultural festivals entail and sharing stories and traditions from various countries promotes positive messages about diversity and inclusivity whilst also developing children's awareness of, and respect for, others' beliefs.

...And of course, not forgetting the most exciting part of Autumn 2 - our EYFS Christmas Show! This will be the children's first school performance where they will begin their journey of developing a creative mind and fostering personalities and imaginations. Having opportunities to perform in front of an audience allow the children to develop creative passions and simultaneously teaching language and communication skills, helping them to communicate effectively with others with confidence.

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We will also explore the lives of nocturnal animals and spend time learning about toys from the past when we explore the tradition of exchanging gifts at Christmas and receiving them on our birthday. In literacy, we will continue to learn many more phonemes and practise applying our phonic knowledge during a variety of writing and reading opportunities.

We will study the artist, Wassily Kandinsky and explore his style of using colour and shapes to create

artwork. This will link to our maths
