EARRINGS

We are aware that a few children have had their ears pierced over the summer holidays. We ask that once earrings are able to be removed, children do this for PE sessions.

If they are unable to remove them – if they are recently pierced – we will use tape to cover them until they can be removed. This is for safety reasons to prevent injury during PE sessions.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind all children that the only earrings that should be worn for school sit only on the ear lobe and do not hang or dangle below the ear. Again, this is for safety reasons to prevent injury.

SCHOOL GATEWAY - COMMUNICATIONS

For our new starters, information was sent home this week regarding our use of the School Gateway app. Communications to Parents will be sent directly into the inbox of the email address we hold on our records for you. School Gateway also provides a safe, secure and easy way to pay online for school items such as school meals. Trips, clubs and other school activities, which can be accessed through the School Gateway app.

The **School Gateway** app is available via Google Play or the App Store. Once you have downloaded the app, please proceed to the home screen and click the link at the bottom to sign up as a new user. Once you have entered your details please press SEND PIN.

Please note that the email address and mobile number must match those held on our records to ensure that you receive email notifications and app messages from the school. Please contact the school office should you need to check the contact records that we hold for you.

Once signed up, you will receive a text message with a unique 4 digit pin number, please keep a note of this number as this is how you will access the **School Gateway** app in the future along with your email address. We will receive a notification that you have successfully downloaded the app.

FOBS – FRIENDS OF BROUGH SCHOOL
